Dear Mr. Gillette:

I am writing you today as Chairman of the Fishhawk Community Development District II (CDD II) with regard to the proposed TECO transmission line corridor adjacent to the FishHawk Ranch Community. Residents within the CDD II portion of the FishHawk Ranch community, which could be impacted the greatest by the installation of this transmission line, have raised numerous concerns regarding potential impacts to their families and property value should TECO elect to construct in this corridor.

The Board of Supervisors, at the May 21, 2012 meeting, voted unanimously to request that TECO re-examine and evaluate alternative routes for the high voltage transmission corridor in order to eliminate and minimize the impact on existing residents within FishHawk Ranch.

The CDD II constructs and maintains a high level of community infrastructure and feels that locating high voltage transmission lines in the proposed area is inconsistent with the overall character and appearance of the Community.

I would also request that the CDD II Board be kept informed of any pending TECO design and construction plans so the District has a clear understanding of any potential impacts to District owned and maintained property such as ponds, drainage facilities and trails.

I will be glad to meet with you regarding possible alternatives at your convenience.
